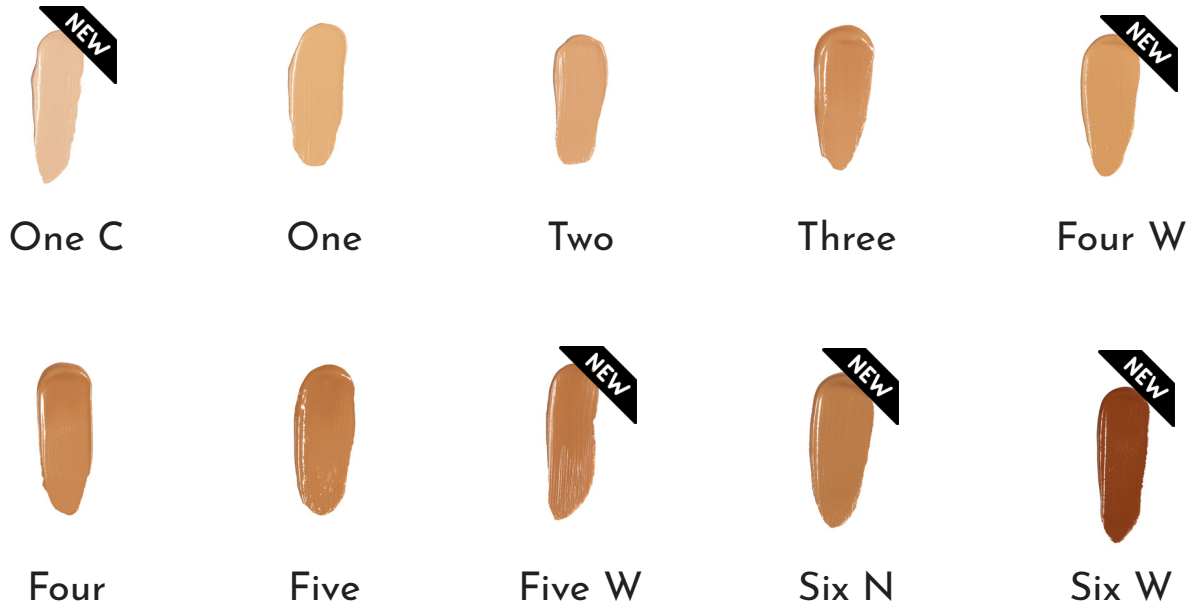

Identifying the right shade for your client

1. Following a quick consultation, select the three closest shades to the client's skin tone.
2. Line the selected shades up in order number.
3. Using cotton tips for liquid foundations and a Kabuki Brush for powder foundations, apply products in order of shade number in three vertical lines down the lower cheek / jawline, leaving space between each line.
4. Allow to settle on skin to reveal true colour.
5. Provide a mirror to the client and work together to determine the most suitable shade, taking into consideration skin tone and personal preference.
